Registration Fee

A one-time non-refundable \$150 fee per child is due with your child's application.

Family Discounts

A discount of \$25 is available for multiple children enrolled in MDO/SSP,

All tuition is based on 10 equal payments due on the 1st of each month.

Mom's Day Out for 5 mos.—2s

- ♥ Low teacher : child ratio (1:4.5 for 5 mos. through 1's, 1:7 for 2's)
- ♥ 8:30 AM—2:30 PM W/F
- ♥ 8:30 AM—2:30 PM M/T/Th
- ♥ 8:30 AM—2:30 PM M-F
- ♥ Options to purchase Early Care beginning at 7:15 and/or Extended Care until 5:00 PM M-F
- ♥ A preschool type day with activities designed to challenge and encourage your child's growth.
- ♥ Thematic monthly units from Kid-Sparkz! Curriculum, that organize developmentally appropriate activities.
- ♥ Introduction to music, art, colors, shapes, the alphabet, counting, and Bible stories in a loving, supportive environment.
- ♥ Stories, nursery rhymes and songs that encourage age-appropriate language development.
- ♥ Toys that encourage exploration and curiosity.
- ♥ Encouragement of proper manners (please, thank you, etc.) including table manners, and self-help skills.

- ♥ A preschool type day with activities designed to challenge and encourage your child's growth.
- ♥ Christian emphasis, including Bible stories and memorizing simple Bible verses and prayers.
- ♥ Core Knowledge curriculum (www.coreknowledge.org), a content-rich curriculum that builds upon itself in a sequential fashion and supports our pre-school curriculum.
- ♥ Opportunities for growth in language development, with a particular focus on phonemic awareness and vocabulary building through stories, rhymes, and songs.
- ♥ Opportunities for age appropriate development of mathematical reasoning through activities involving sorting, counting, one-to-one correspondence, and patterning.
- ♥ Opportunities for large motor development through obstacle courses, running, dancing, hopping/jumping, balancing, tumbling, throwing and kicking. Games are used to facilitate listening skills as well as develop motor coordination.

- ♥ A preschool day that includes large group opening exercises, centers, and small group time.
- ♥ Christian emphasis, including Bible stories and memorizing simple Bible verses and prayers.
- ♥ Core Knowledge curriculum (www.coreknowledge.org), a content-rich kindergarten readiness curriculum that builds upon itself in a sequential fashion. The curriculum focuses on
 - ◇ Literacy
 - ◇ Stories and nursery rhymes

 - ◇ Science
